Dr Graham Furness graduated in medicine from the University of Western Australia in 1987 and worked for a number of years at Royal Perth Hospital, prior to commencing ophthalmology training. He completed this in 1996 and then underwent further subspecialty training in the United Kingdom.

Dr Furness has extensive experience in cataract and refractive surgery, utilising the latest techniques and technology. He has been performing refractive surgery, including laser and lens procedures since 1997. Specialising in cataract and refractive surgery, Dr Furness was one of the first surgeons in Perth to regularly perform cataract surgery using the small incision no needle technique under eyedrop (topical) anaesthetic.

Dr Furness is a founding member of the Australasian Society of Cataract and Refractive Surgeons and also a member of the American Society of Cataract and Refractive Surgeons. Despite his busy private practice, Dr Furness is also a consultant eye surgeon at Joondalup Health Campus and Osborne Park Hospital. He is a current Board Member and previous Chairman of the Perth Eye Centre - a charitable organisation which provides funding for ophthalmic research and provision of eye surgery in under-developed countries.

Dr Furness enjoys spending time with his wife and three children and is an enthusiastic rally driver, having regularly competed in Rally Australia, Targa Tasmania and Targa West.
